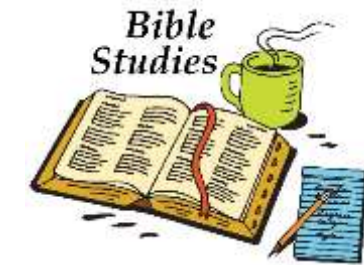
The Greeters as you entered were the Lauren Halsey, Caroline Luss, Turner West, and Faith Duggal.
