Pastor Rick recommends the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV), New International Version (NIV), or The Good News Bible. All excellent, updated, English translations.

Avoid: The Living Bible and The King James Bible.

Also, he recommends that, whatever translation you choose, get a study Bible: that is, a Bible with notes, maps, concordance, etc. They're a little more costly, but worth it.
