**Items are needed to make up the Christmas Bazaar Baskets for sale or auction:**

**Beauty/Spa Basket**- Lotions, oils, soaps, bath sponge, scrubber, mirror, nail treatment items, nail polish, polish remover, hand cream, cotton balls.

**Baker's Basket** – cake pans, muffin tins, mixing bowls, whisk, scrapers, spoons, cake plate, mixes for cake and frosting
